



Criteria for Re-Accreditation EMDR Europe

1. Practitioner/Therapists Experts in EMDR must request re-accreditation to their National Association EMDR every five years.
2. Re-Accreditation will allow the Practitioner to continue to be part of the list of Practitioner/Therapists Experts in EMDR on the website of their National Association EMDR. The website of EMDR Europe Association has the links of all member countries and is therefore visible to all other countries.
3. Re-accreditation of the Practitioner guarantees that they apply EMDR regularly in their clinical practice and address the problems and disorders of the patient on the basis of the model of Adaptive Information Processing (AIP).
4. The request for re-accreditation must include:
 - a. Being in compliance with the annual association fees of the National Association (Association EMDR Italy) and having a letter of "Good standing", of being in good relations, on the part of the Association EMDR Italy
 - b. Proof of having acquired 50 CPD (Continuing Personal Development) credits in the course of the 5 years elapsed since the last accreditation. (10 CPD credits per year).

The events that grant credits are the participation in:

 - *Annual Conference of EMDR Europe (14 CPD credits)*
 - *Congress of the Association EMDR Italy (10 CPD credits)*
 - *Specialist Seminars of EMDR Italy for members (1 CPD credit per hour of lesson)*
 - *Specialist Seminars of EMDR Italy for Practitioners and Supervisors (8 CPD credits)*
 - c. The National Association EMDR has discretionary power regarding the criteria for re-accreditation.
 - d. If re-accreditation is not requested or the applicant does not meet the standard requirements, their accreditation will be withdrawn, determining the cancellation from the list of Practitioner/Therapists Experts in EMDR, Accredited by EMDR Europe, from the website of their National Association EMDR.
 - e. If re-accreditation is not requested or not granted, the member will not be able to qualify as Practitioner/Expert in EMDR, Accredited by EMDR Europe or use the title of Practitioner/Expert in EMDR, Accredited by EMDR Europe on their professional cards or communications.
 - f. The Practitioner whose accreditation by EMDR Europe will expire and who will not request re-accreditation "decade" and will have to redo the accreditation process as practitioner.
